**A Midweek WHA visit**

**Hughenden:**

Amid rolling Chilterns countryside, discover the hideaway and colourful private life of Benjamin Disraeli, the most unlikely Victorian Prime Minister. Relax in his elegant garden and imagine dining with Queen Victoria in the atmospheric manor. Also there is the Second World War story of Operation Hillside, for which unconventional artists painted maps for bombing missions - including the Dambusters raid. Outdoors, get tips for growing your own vegetables in the walled garden.

**Refreshments:** We suggest you have lunch at Hughenden and afternoon tea at Chenies Manor. Both venues have limited space for too many folk at the same time. A packed lunch might be appropriate, there are picnic benches in the park area..

**Chenies Manor Gardens:**

Chenies Manor is the home of the MacLeod Matthews family. The 14<sup>th</sup> & 15<sup>th</sup> century Manor House is the original home of the Earls of Bedford, visited by Henry VIII and Elizabeth 1. The manor is surrounded by five acres of gardens. From early June there is a succession of colour in the Tudor Sunken garden, The White garden, Herbaceous borders and Fountain Court, with a special display of many varieties of Dahlias. The physic garden contains a selection of medicinal & culinary herbs, the Parterre has an ancient Oak and a Yew Maze, & the kitchen garden is in Victorian style with unusual vegetables & fruit. The visit is to the gardens only.

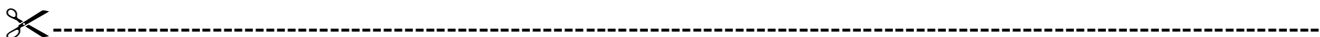
